## Voting instructions for Both P/C Election and Staff Poll

### Paper Ballot Voting Instructions

**PAPER BALLOT VOTING INSTRUCTIONS**  
 LOCAL SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

**POST TWO INSTRUCTION CARDS IN AND ABOUT POLLING PLACE**

Any person wanting to vote should arrive before or at the election judge. The voter shall sign the appropriate Affidavit, confirming that he/she is a qualified voter, qualified to vote at the local school council election.

In order to mark the ballot in a legally approved manner, it is necessary for the voter to know the distinctions between valid and invalid marks. According to Illinois law, a voter must indicate his/her choice on a ballot by placing a mark ("X") made with the covered (opaque) the name of the candidate; the voter makes marks for votes. A valid cross mark consists of two lines which intersect inside the square.

## Sample Ballot for Both Parent/Community and Staff Poll

Judges will inform all voters that, after voting, they must:

- Fold the ballot in half, twice, (instructions are on the back of the ballot);
- Deposit ballot in the ballot box or hand it to a judge to deposit in ballot box
- Initial the official ballot and hand it to the voter and direct voter to the voting station.
