



While providing challenging and intentional programming, Chicago Builds' mission is to provide students pathways to the building trades after high school. Our passion is to inspire students to do incredible things. Chicago Builds serves as a model for specialized trade schools for high school students interested in working in the building trades as a post-secondary career. Chicago Builds is an IL Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program site and offers the Master Builder program in collaboration with City Colleges of Chicago.

#### Who can apply?

*Any 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grader in good standing towards graduation is eligible to apply for a seat in Chicago Builds*

#### When do students apply?

We encourage interested students to apply between February and May of their Sophomore or Junior year of high school.

#### Where do I get the application?

#### Is Chicago Builds an accredited course?

Students can earn up to 5 credits over the two-year span (1.25 credits/semester you attend the program)

#### What are the qualifications?

There are no minimum requirements to apply. However, students should be interested in construction, committed to attending the program each day, and willing to take advantage of work-based learning opportunities as they arise.

#### What time of the day is Chicago Builds run?

Chicago Builds offers two cohorts per day; AM cohort (8:30 am-10:30 am) and PM cohort (1:45 pm-3:45 pm). Students must work with their home school's counselor to determine which session fits into their schedule.

Chicago Builds offers students interested in a career in the building trades access to:

- High school credits in a hands-on class (up to 5 credits)
- Technical skills needed to start a career after high school
- Certifications required for a career in construction
- Preparation for union entrance exams
- Integration of Construction Math and Literacy skills in classes
- Dual Credit opportunities
- Access to marketable construction industry disciplines
- Entrepreneurship skill development
- Networking and Resume Writing Supports
- 6 Seasoned industry-trained instructors
- 5 Industry specific training suites
- Paid Summer job placement/internships
- Dedicated post-secondary support teams
- Workplace and job shadowing opportunities

### How does Chicago Builds Work?

**Level 1** Students participate in four, 10-week rotations between the construction pathways. During each rotation, students will learn from and network with industry experts in the construction field. After the four rotations are completed by year-end, students are encouraged to select one area of concentration (Electricity or Carpentry for Level II Curriculum).

**Level 2:** After students complete the level I rotations at Chicago Builds, students are able to apply to return for level II. During the level II pathways, students' post-secondary plans begin to take a more defined shape. Along with concentrating on one specific curriculum area, students are trained daily in preparation for potential apprenticeship entrance examinations. The daily subject matter in level II is designed to prepare each student to move easily into the construction workforce or pre-apprenticeship programs for the various construction trades. Level II



admission is not guaranteed to students who have/have not participated in level I.

## Chicago Builds Application Process

The application for the Chicago Builds citywide construction training program is open to all rising 11th and 12th grade (current 10th and 11th grade) CPS & Charter students. Applications will be accepted beginning until June. While there are no minimum academic requirements for admission to Chicago Builds, priority will be given to rising Juniors entering the program.

Applications will be complete for students once they submit all associated application paperwork including the Student & Parent Expectations and Consent Contract and the Recommendation Form.
