

Scoring Pubric High School Programs

Overview - 900 Points

The application scoring system considers the CPS High School Admissions Test (HSAT) (50% of the total) and seventh-grade grades for core subjects (50% of the total). The weights for the scoring components are established by using a total of 900 points, with each 50% element worth 450 points.

CPS High School Admissions Test (HSAT) -450 Points

Points from the HSAT are determined by multiplying the percentile by 2.2727 to get a maximum score of 225, so that Reading and Math together yield a maximum of 450 points. You can use the table below to determine your point total.

Seventh Grade Grades - 450 Points

Points are calculated for reading, mathematics, science, and social studies. Each 'A' grade is worth 112.5 points, 'B' is worth 75 points, and 'C' is worth 38 points. No points are awarded for 'D' or 'F' grades. You can use the GRADES table to determine your point totals.

Geographic Area Bonus for Certain Programs - 50 Points

Certain programs provide a 50-point bonus for students who reside within a school's geographic location just prior to selections. For these programs, a student can receive a total of 950 points, with the CPS High School Admissions Test and grades each comprising 47.37% of the total points at 450 each, and the 50-point attendance area preference allocation comprising 5.26% of just prior to selections.
